5. Reflection or update on recent Parish events and programmes:
 - a. **Jubilee of sick and healthcare workers** – A very good service, all the oil/salt packs taken up.
 - b. **Parish Lenten One Day Retreat** – Forty parishioners attended and there was plenty of food available.
 - c. **Easter celebrations** – A busy programme with a feeling that the liturgies were special. The Youth Stations were very well done.
 - d. **Anzac Day mass** – A good service. Only one ex-serviceperson attended.
 - e. **Jubilee of people with disabilities / Divine Mercy** – A very good mass. Well done Liturgy, Youth and Music Groups!

6. Upcoming faith events:
 - a. 1 May to 12 June – Life in the Spirit Seminar: 20 enrolments so far.
 - b. 11 May - Mothers' Day: Jubilee of Mothers: some discussion here. In the past, CWL has done flowers. Suggestion that youth could practice a song for after Mass. But we could have difficulty in getting the youth to arrange this. Agreed that it is too late for youth to organise and the schools are out of contention. Suggestion of flowers from JPD; special blessing for mothers; fathers to bring a plate.
 - c. 18 May – Ōtari Parish AGM: cf (7) below.
 - d. 25 May - World Children's Day: Jubilee of Children: some discussion on this. Do we tie in with the Cathedral? Youth Group planning a children's event after Mass? Check this with Liturgy Group. Agreed to encourage parents (schools) to bring children.
 - e. 28 May - Catholic Schools Day: not on our roster, leave with Liturgy Committee and schools.
 - f. 8 June - Parish Anniversary - Combined Mass: cf below.
 - g. 8 June - Pentecost Sunday: Jubilee of Cultures: both on the same day. Lead by Liturgy Committee, to arrange readers and prayers of the Faithful. Big morning tea after 10 am Mass.
 - h. 22 June - First Holy Eucharist 10am Mass: Liturgy Committee to handle.
